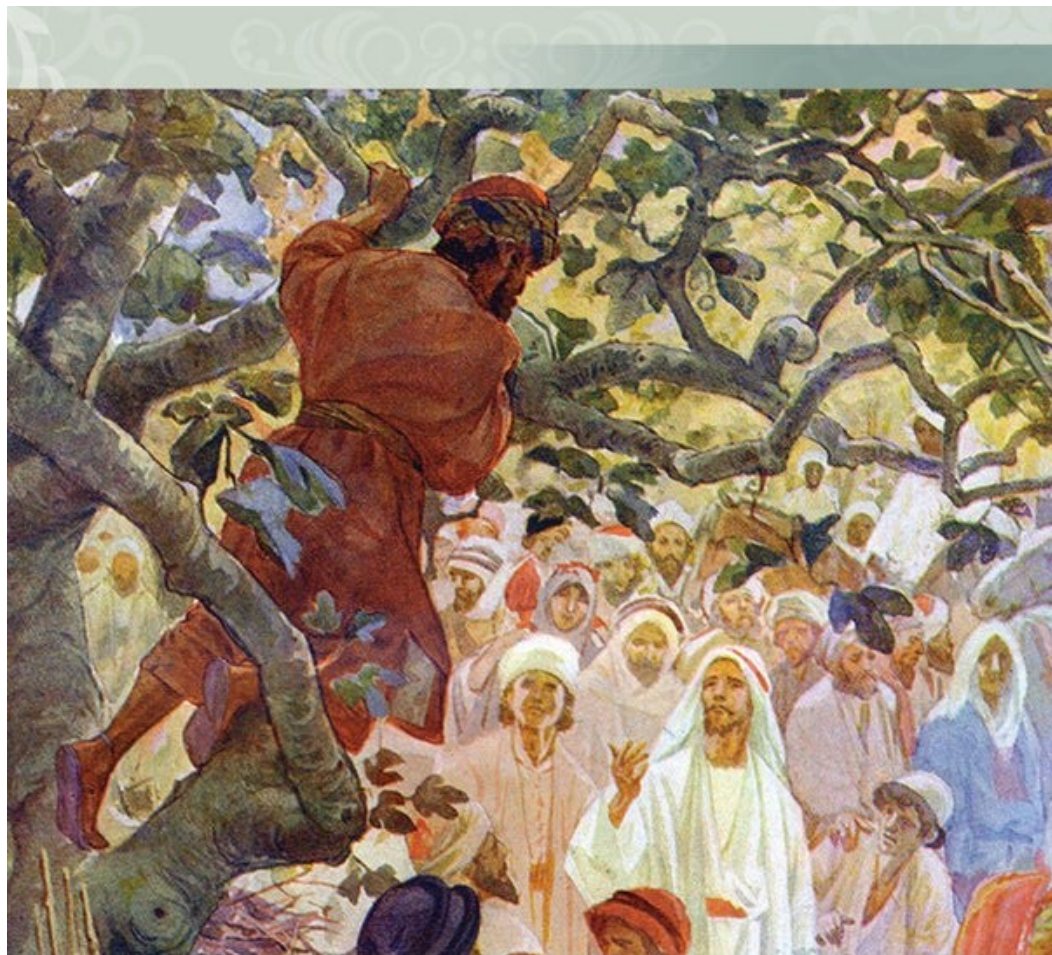

Gospel Summary & Question of the Week

Read Sunday's Gospel, Lk 19: 1—10

Thirty– First Sunday in Ordinary Time- Cycle C

A Family Perspective:

Jesus is saying to you what he said to Zacchaeus, “I must stay at your house today.” It doesn’t matter if, in today’s gospel, Jesus “intended to pass through Jericho to another town.” In families we sometimes stop at the wrong places. It is wisdom to “pass through” annoying family situations so we can enjoy the goodness of each other.

Dear Parishioners

One night recently our Parish looked like this: Prayer at 5 pm at Church with one group; Prayer at 6 pm with another; a meeting in the Cafeteria; and, a meeting in Church. Now that's parish life. People were coming and going. Most importantly, people were being nourished and strengthened in faith. WE NEED more days and nights like this. Many of us remember the days when parish life was the center of our lives and activities. We wouldn't have skipped Sunday Mass nor most of the activities in the parish. Yes, times have changed and things have changed. We are busy working, taking care of our children, parents, and families. But in the midst of this, we have to ask ourselves what is the foundation for these things we do? Is it our faith? Is the Eucharist that **"Summit toward which our activities are aimed" and the "Source from which our power flows?"** If not, with what have we replaced it? Our own designs? Our own understanding of faith? Prayer without connection to our community of faith? The Church constantly offers opportunities for grace and renewal. In our parish and area, there are many of these, and they vary in terms of styles so that everyone should find *something* that helps them. I have more "up my sleeve" that we will be able to choose from in winter and in Lent. When you see these opportunities, please mark them on your calendar (however you calendar these days...). Promise yourself that you will take advantage of a chance to strengthen that foundation that enables you to do all that you do. Otherwise, we are, as Paul says, liable to become *"noisy gongs" and clanging cymbals,* doing a lot but accomplishing little. As I mentioned at one of those meetings, we have come to believe, in our time, that salvation is a given. But such is not the case. The Lord expects us to respond to the call of faith. Failure to do so has disastrous consequences for both our endeavors in the here and now and our hopes for the Reign of God. Let us not kid ourselves. Thank you to those who respond in faith to so much that goes on here and in our faith community. Please continue to invite others to join us in our walk of faith.
